



The 47th JLRS Party Contest

**New Email address for log submission!*

- 1. ORGANIZER:** Japan Ladies Radio Society (JLRS)
- 2. OBJECTIVE:** For YL stations to promote active contacts and interaction with as many other stations as possible.
- 3. DATE:** Phone - Starts at 03:00UTC on September 29, 2018
Ends at 03:00UTC on September 30, 2018
CW - Starts at 03:00UTC on October 6, 2018
Ends at 03:00UTC on October 7, 2018
- 4. ELIGIBILITY:** All licensed male and female operators in the world
*(*Contacts with club stations and special stations are valid, but only Individual stations can submit their contest logs.)*
- 5. FREQUENCIES:** 1.9MHz – 1200MHz (Except WARC bands)
Operations on 3.5MHz and up to 430MHz have to be on the contest frequency bands designated by JARL. *(See page 4)*
- 6. CATEGORIES:**
OM-Phone Category, OM-CW Category,
YL-Phone Category, YL-CW Category,
(Submit phone log and CW log separately.)
- 7. REQUIREMENTS:**
 - 1) Operating location must not be changed unless you switch to the different mode.
 - 2) Contacts with 1 or more JLRS member stations must be included in the contest log.
**The log without JLRS member will be categorized as checklog.*

**OM to OM contacts are not valid.*

8. CALL:

For Phone, OM calls "CQ YL," and YL calls "CQ contest."

For CW, OM calls "CQ YL," and YL calls "CQ TEST."

9. CONTEST EXCHANGE:

JLRS member: RS(T) + serial number starting 5001

YL: RS(T) + serial number starting 2001

OM: RS(T) + serial number starting 001

**The serial number must be continued if you QSY to a different band.*

**Multiple contacts with the same station are allowed if they are on the different band.*

10. PROHIBITIONS:

- 1) Contacts on cross mode, cross band, via Internet
- 2) Contacts with mobile stations (on vehicle, ship, airplane)

11. POINTS:

OM: Contact with a YL station counts 1 point, and a JLRS member station counts 5 points.

YL: Contact with an OM station counts 1 point, and a YL station counts 5 points.

12. MULTIPLIER: Prefixes on each band

13. TOTAL SCORE:

The final score is the result of the total QSO points on each band multiplied by the sum of total multipliers on each band.

14. LOG INSTRUCTIONS:

1) Paper log:

Use JARL format or Letter size summary sheet.

Use a separate log sheet for each band, and write prefixes as multipliers. (e.g. JA1)

Electronic log:

Use JARL SUMMARYSHEET VERSION=R1.0 for JA stations.

Use Cabrillo format for DX stations.

- 2) If you would like to receive a participant sticker, write the request in the comment section of your summary sheet.
- 3) Write your e-mail address for inquiries.

15. LOG SUBMISSION:

Send your contest log and summary sheet by postal mail to Mitsuko Ikegi JA3SMT, 3-19-23 Hannan-cho, Abeno-ku, Osaka, 545-0021, JAPAN.

Submission by e-mail is also accepted. Send them to ja3smt.log(at)gmail.com. (**New email address*)

16. PRIZES:

- 1) Certificates are awarded to the 1st-, 2nd-, and 3rd-place winners in each category.
- 2) Participant sticker is issued to each category.

17. INQUIRY: Send email to ja3smt(at)jarl.com.

18. DEADLINE: Log and summary sheet must be received by October 20, 2018.

19. RESULTS:

Results will be announced on JLRS website in December.
The result table will be mailed if asked with a SASE.
